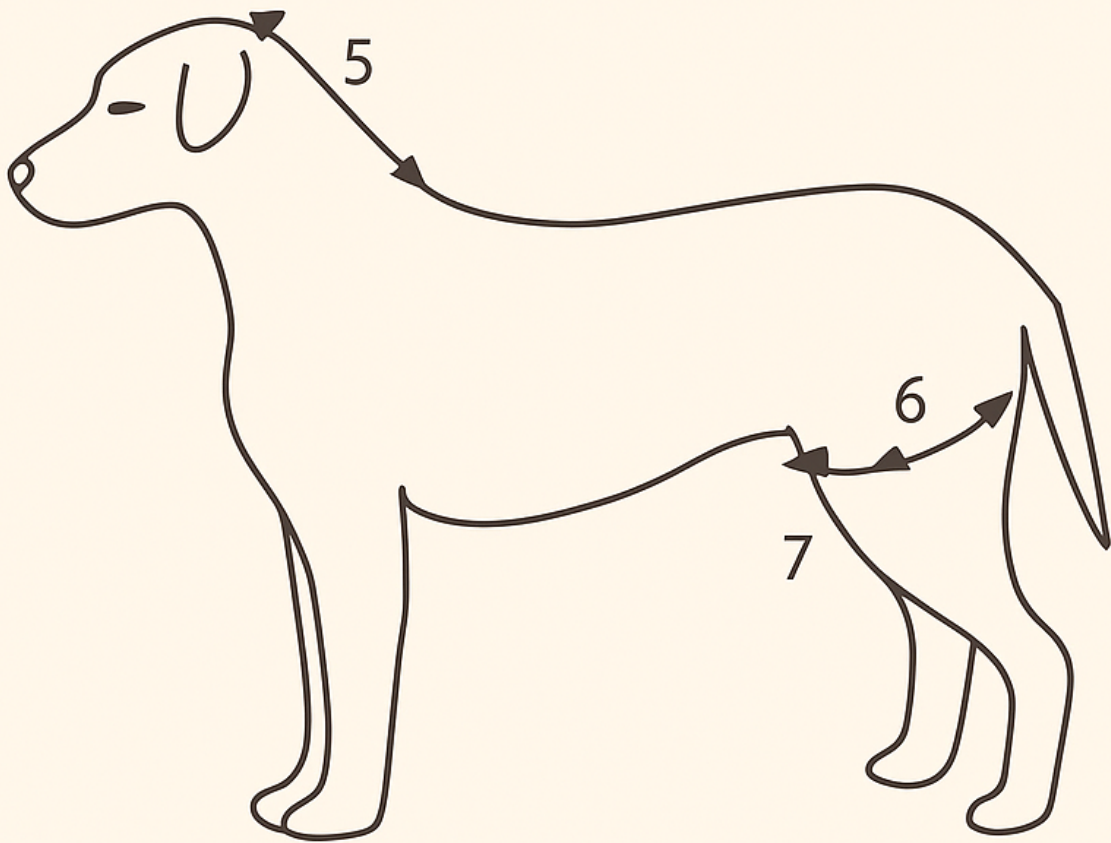
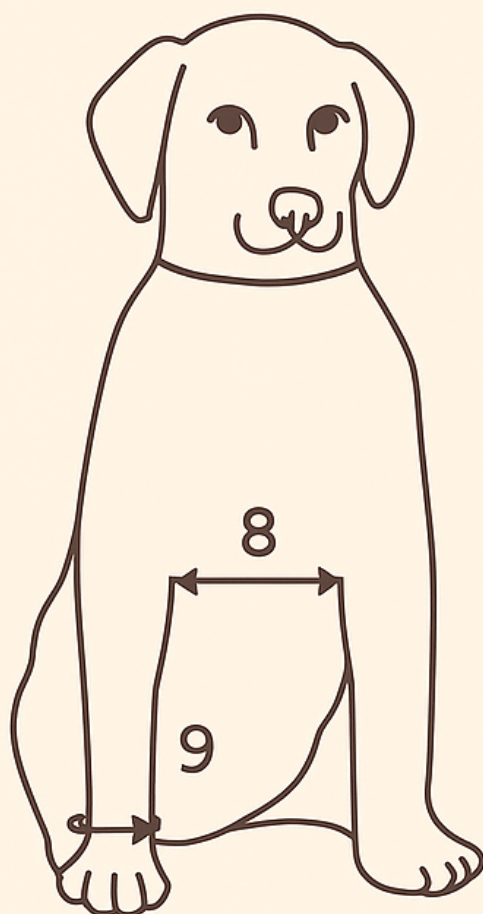


1. Back length – Stand your dog, lift its head, and find the point where the neck transitions into the back (at the shoulder blades). Measure from this point to the base of the tail.
2. Neck circumference – Measure where the collar usually sits.
3. Chest circumference – Measure at the widest part of the chest, just behind the front legs.
4. Waist circumference – Measure just in front of the hind legs.





- 5. Neck length – Measure from back to base of the ears.
- 6. Thigh circumference – Measure at the widest part of the thigh.
- 7. Hind leg length – Measure to the hock joint.



8. Paw Distance — Measure the distance between the front paws at the chest line.
9. Paw Circumference — Measure the circumference of the front paw.
